Key responsibilities:

TLT-Tomorrow's Leaders today is currently looking for an entry level intern to help complete data research regarding resources across Texas that are available to populations in or aging out of adoption/foster care, underserved communities, and rural communities.

Work Schedule:

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

One-Hour long virtual weekly team meeting

Options: Tues 7:30am, 9:00am, Tues 1030am, Tues 1200pm

AND

Bi-weekly position specific virtual coaching sessions held under the supervision of a supervisor.

September 3rd to November 15th check your schedule prior to applying.

Work hours are flexible, but you must commit to working 10-20 hours per week.

Applicants must reside in Texas and be a US Citizen.

Responsibilities will include:

-In this role, you will conduct data collection and mixed methods research that supports ongoing analysis of the dynamics of one of the following:

-Youth 13-18 in foster care and youth aging out of adoption in Texas

-Youth 13-25 in underserved communities across Texas

Specific projects may include:

-Researching, compiling, and documenting state-specific data sets of youth 13-18 in foster care and youth aging out of adoption in Texas

-Cataloging data sources and gathering data on a variety of community socio-economic health indicators in underserved communities

-Studying how communities finance and budget youth 13-18 in foster care and youth aging out of adoption or youth on free and reduced lunch programs

-Writing memos or brief reports that document practices and summarize findings

Qualifications:

- Enrolled in a technology program
- Comfort and interest in working with data, collecting data, and preparing data for analysis
- Commitment to advancing underserved adolescents, ages 13-25, as well as racial, gender and sexual orientation equity
- Curiosity about emerging research and advocacy in youth development space
- Strong writing skills
- Proficient with Microsoft Office Suite
- Strong attention to detail and a self-driven desire to develop and drive value in the organization

About this internship program

The TLT- Leading Leaders Intern program consists of a unique opportunity to offer real world experience in multiple disciplines that bring to life the knowledge gained in academics.
